



GS3 Paddle - Group Bleeding Instructions

Warning: The group bleeding procedure should be done immediately after the boilers have been filled and prior to the machine warming up. Waiting for the machine to heat up may cause hot water to exit the bleeding screw and burn the user so it is very important to do while the machine is cold. La Marzocco and it's distributors assume no liability for injury and or damage occurred for failing to follow this warning.



Step 1 - Using the provided 4mm allen wrench, unscrew the two allen screws on the top of the plastic group cover.

Note: The two screws have retaining collars on the bottom of the group and will stay attached to the group cover.



Step 2 - Remove the plastic group cover to expose the group bleeding screw.



Step 3 - With the machine on and still cold, move the paddle to the left (brew) position. Using the provided 5mm allen wrench loosen the screw approximately 1/2 turn. When water exits the screw then immediately tighten the screw and then move the paddle to the right (off) position. Reassemble the group cover and the bleeding procedure is complete.
